



# STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

## RIGHT

1. I have the right to be treated with respect, politeness and with fairness.
2. I have the right to be safe.
3. I have the right to expect my property to be safe.
4. I have the right to receive a good education.

## RESPONSIBILITY

- I have the responsibility to treat others politely and with respect.
- I have the responsibility to respect the authority of staff members.
- If necessary, I should be able disagree without being disagreeable.
- I have the responsibility not to do anything which may threaten or cause danger to myself or others.
- It is my responsibility to report to a staff member any situations that may lead to personal danger.
- I have the responsibility to not steal, damage or destroy the property of others.
- I have the responsibility to ask permission before using the property of someone else and to be responsible for its safe return to the owner.
- I have the responsibility to take proper care of School property.
- I have the responsibility to co-operate with teachers and other students so that class work can proceed and that I keep up-to-date with required work.
- I have the responsibility not to behave so as to interfere with others' study.
- I have the responsibility to be punctual and take part positively in learning activities.



## RIGHT

5. I have the right to be protected against threats to my health.
6. I have the right to a pleasant, clean and well maintained School environment.
7. I have the right to be educated in hygienic, neat and clean classrooms and learning areas.
8. I have the right to benefit from the good name of the school.
9. I have the right to make decisions for myself, which do not compromise another person's right or freedom.
10. I have the right to be trusted.
11. I have the right to expect that all these rights will be mine so long as I am carrying out my full responsibilities.

## RESPONSIBILITY

- I have the responsibility not to smoke, take alcohol or other drugs or to influence others to do so.
- I have the responsibility to engage in sporting activities designed for healthy living
- I have the responsibility not to litter, to care for the environment and to be prepared to remove litter.
- I have the responsibility to keep my desk and classroom neat, clean and hygienic.
- I have the responsibility to behave so that the community will respect my school. It is my responsibility to dress in accordance with the school dress code
- I have a responsibility to make sensible decisions and to face the consequences of my decisions.
- I have the responsibility to respect the truth and to be honest in all matters
- I have the responsibility to protect my rights and the rights of others by carrying out my full responsibilities at all times.

## STUDENT CONCERNS

If I have a concern about anything involving my school life, I should inform my class teacher. If I do not get a satisfactory response from my class teacher then I should raise my concern with my parent/carer(s). If I am unable to raise my concern with my parent/carer(s). then I should talk to the Realm Coordinator or Head of School.
